ORAL ORDER

2 08-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State through the virtual Court proceedings.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Allegation is of recovery of 31.500 litres of liquor.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and he was not arrested from the spot, as such, nothing was recovered from his conscious possession and he was falsely implicated by the local people with whom he is on inimical term.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the



event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Danapur P.S. Case No. 772 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
