On careful perusal of the said order dated 03.02.2016, it is evident that there was no specific direction to the

This contempt proceeding is accordingly dropped. It is again reiterated that the petitioner shall have the liberty to approach the authorities if, according to her, she is entitled to received more amount than what has been paid to her.
