the Superintendent of Police, Saran, Chapra (respondent no.4) to

delay in conclusion of the investigation and in case it is found

that the I.O. is not taking interest in completion of investigation

of the case, the I.O. should be changed immediately and



appropriate instructions be issued to ensure completion of investigation within a reasonable period.

This application stands disposed of accordingly.
