ORAL ORDER

2 26-05-2022 The learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove all the defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter within one
month.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
APP for the State.

This is an application for regular bail on behalf of the
petitioner for the offences alleged under section 30(a) of Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the
alleged liquor was not recovered from possession of the petitioner
rather it was recovered from the house of Bhola Paswan. He
submitted further that the petitioner is accused in one case of similar
nature but in the present case he is in custody since 10.12.2021.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, **let**



the petitioner above named be released on bail only after framing of the charge on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Addl. Sessions Judge II-cum- Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with Riga P.S. Case no. 43 of 2020.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioner within the stipulated time mentioned hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
