2 26-05-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 33 of 2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 398,302,307,120B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)A, 27 and 35 of the Arms Act.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR. He has been named by the co-accused in his confessional statement that he has not been found in the CCTV footage. A person who has confessed and named the petitioner has been granted bail. The



petitioner is in custody since 09.04.2021.

Considering the period of custody and the allegation levelled against the petitioner, the petitioner above-named is directed to be enlarged on bail **after framing of charge, if already has not been framed** on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-Vlth Supaul in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 33 of 2021.
