Petitioners apprehend their arrest in Kathaiya P.S.

Case No.156 of 2019 registered under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is submitted that there is no specific allegation against the petitioners. Petitioner nos.1, 2 and 3 are father-in-law, brother-in-law and sister-in-law, respectively, of the deceased.
