- 2 04-08-2022 Though the present writ petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 11.07.2017, passed by the Commissioner, Magadh Division, Gaya, whereby and whereunder the appeal has been dismissed and the order dated 16.11.2012, passed by the D.C.L.R., Sadar, Gaya in Land Dispute Case no. 185 of 2012-13 has been upheld, by which the case of the petitioner has been rejected on the ground that the dispute in question pertains to the right, title and interest of private parties over the land in question, but the learned counsel for the petitioner has confined his relief to grant of liberty to the petitioner to approach the competent Civil court having



appropriate jurisdiction. Liberty so sought, is granted.

The present writ petition stands disposed off.
