Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner above named, in the event of her arrest or surrender, within four weeks from today, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Supaul in connection with Chatapur P.S.
