the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection
with Khaira P.S. Case No. 202 of 2020 registered for the
offence punishable under sections 304B, 201, 120B/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners
submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this
case merely because they are the relatives of the husband of
the deceased. Nothing specific is alleged against these
petitioners. The petitioners are separate in residence and

mess from the husband of the deceased from before, as is evident from the Batbaranama and Rasan Card, enclosed as Annexures-2 and 3. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamui in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 202 of 2020 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
