It has been brought notice to this Court that despite
the order dated 08.03.2022, whereby the parties were directed to
appear before the District Mediation Centre, Nalanda for
exploring the amicable solution of the dispute and despite the
order that interim protection granted to the petitioner vide order
dated 21.01.2022 shall remain in force, the police arrested the
petitioner.

Vide order dated 21.01.2022, there was direction of
this Court not to take coercive step against the petitioner. The
Superintendent of Police, Nalanda is directed to send a report as



to how the police arrested the petitioner violating the order of this Court. The report must be received in Court within a week from today.
