Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s).

“ 1.That this is an application to pass appropriate writ or writs, order or orders and direction or directions in the nature of mandamus directing upon the Respondents to exempt the fine on the certificate of fitness of Bus No. BR-07P-4056 from 5.12.2018 to up till now.”
