In the instant petition, petitioners have prayed for the following relief(s):-



“(i) For direction to the respondent authorities to grant the upgradcd pay scale of Rs. 2000-3800/- w.e.f. 24.01.1994 to 31.12.1995 as has been granted to other similarly situated members of Bihar Agriculture Sub Ordinate Service, Category-9 (statistics) with all consequential monetary benefit and accordingly, fix and revise the pay scale of the petitioners accordingly.

(ii) For any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioners are found entitled to.”

In support of the aforesaid relief petitioner is stated to have submitted number of representations dated 07.01.2016, 16.01.2020 and 27.08.2020 vide Annexure-4, 5 and 6 series and also Judgment of this Court. The concerned authority has not take any action either accepting or rejecting the petitioner's claim.

The concerned respondent is hereby directed to decide petitioners grievance in passing speaking order, if the petitioners are entitled to the relief sought in the present petition. Necessary calculation shall be made and amount shall be disbursed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of this of this order. If the petitioners are not eligible in that event necessary speaking order shall be passed as to why the pe-



tioners are not entitled and the same shall be communicated to the petitioners within a period of three months from the date of receipt of this order.

With the aforesaid observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
