The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Bela P.S. Case No.73 of 2020 registered for offences under Sections 304B, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are co-villagers of the accused persons and also in view of the fact that there is general and omnibus allegation against them, their



application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Accordingly, let petitioners, above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sadar Sitamarhi, District Sitamarhi in connection with Bela P.S. Case No.73 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
