Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

(a) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus for commanding and directing the Respondent authority to pay the total admitted dues of Rs 27,60,000=00 (Rupees twenty seven lacks and sixty thousand only) with 15% interest to the Petitioner for supply of 35000 Sand Challan Book and 5000 Traffic Challan Book for printing order given to the Petitioner



through National Small Industries Corporation Ltd (NSIC)
Government of India.

(b) For issuance of a appropriate writ directing the Respondent authorities if any return the security deposit paid by the petitioner and for any other relief(s) for which the petitioner may be found entitled to in the facts and circumstances of the present case.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petitioner shall be content if the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum and/or take recourse to such other alternative remedies, equally efficacious in law.

Permission granted.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings are initiated, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.



It is made clear that we have not expressed any opinion on merits. All issues are left open.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
