APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Kauwakol(Rupo) P.S. Case no. 262 of 2019 instituted for the offence under Sections 366(A) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case relates to abduction of daughter of the informant by the several accused persons for performing her marriage with the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. There is love affair between the petitioner and daughter of the informant. Statement of the victim girl has got been



recorded in which she has stated that out of her own sweet will, she has eloped from her house and performed marriage with the petitioner. She has not raised any finger against him for any offence. Age of the daughter of the informant has been accessed as 19 years by the lower court.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Kauwakol (Rupo) P.S. Case no. 262 of 2019, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-I, Nawada subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
