The learned counsels for the petitioners have submitted that the FIR itself shows that both the parties run orchestra and some disputes arose between them regarding the girl performing services in orchestra and it was the reason that the petitioners have been implicated. The learned counsels have submitted further that the informant and his friend were brought to the community centre and not to the lonely place which shows that it was not a case of kidnapping. It has also been submitted that for the same occurrence, another case has also been lodged being Sathi P.S. Case No. 12 of 2020, in which the petitioners are on bail.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before court below within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each, with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM III, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Sathi P.S. Case No. 11 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Office shall ensure that all the defects are removed by the petitioners within the stipulated time provided hereinabove,



failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this
Court.
