2 07-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Excise Case No. 201 of 2020 registered under Section
30(a) of the Excise Act.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case.

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State
opposed the prayer of the petitioner by contending that
petitioner has criminal antecedent. Further he contended that on
perusal of seizure list, it transpires that the alleged illicit liquor
has been recovered from the house of this petitioner. Hence, this

is not a fit case of anticipatory bail.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the State, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer of the petitioner is rejected.
