ORAL ORDER

2 02-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State through virtual Court proceedings.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that she secured appointment as *panchayat shikshak* on forged and fabricated marksheet of intermediate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is woman having clean antecedent, it is further submitted that petitioner initially was appointed as *panchayat shikshak* based on her matriculation certificate as pleaded in paragraph '9' of the anticipatory bail application. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner is a lady and has two



daughters and a son to look after and her husband has also died and in view of the provisions of the Cr.P.C., special consideration be given to the petitioner being a woman.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Itarhi P.S. Case No. 06 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
