the appellate authority within a period of 30 days, the same



shall be taken up for consideration and after giving reasonable opportunity to the petitioner to represent his cause, a final order shall be passed by the appellate authority within the next 60 days, giving reasons in support of the decision.

The order so passed by the authority shall be made available to the petitioner forthwith.

With the aforesaid observation/direction, this writ petition is disposed of.
