Petitioners apprehend their arrest in Ishipur, Barahat
P.S. Case No.47 of 2019 registered under Sections 307, 379 and
other minor sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners have committed no offence and have falsely been
implicated in this case. It is further submitted that there is no
specific allegation against the petitioners. They are said to be the

members of the mob. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Case No.47 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
