The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379 and 411/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of theft in the NTPC premises by the accused persons including the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the name of the petitioner came into light on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Sonu Kumar and petitioner has no concern with the said co-accused.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri P.K.Tiwary, Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Barh, District-Patna/concerned Court in connection with NTPC P.S. Case No. 34 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
