the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Srinagar (Pujahan) P.S. Case No. 33 of 2020 registered for the offence punishable under sections 363, 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 8 of the POCSO Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. The present first information report has been lodged after three weeks of the alleged occurrence without there being any plausible explanation for the delay. Petitioners

have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge VI-cum-Special Judge, POCSO Act, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Srinagar (Pujahan) P.S. Case No. 33 of 2020 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
