Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Raghopur P.S. Case No. 257 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 304-B, 328/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased and there is specific allegation against her of torture for demand of dowry.

In the opinion of this Court, this is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is dismissed. However, if the petitioner surrenders in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and seeks regular bail, the Court below shall



consider and decide the same in accordance with law without
being influenced by the order of this Court.
