Earlier, vide order dated 08.12.2021, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail as against petitioner nos.1 and 3 was dismissed as withdrawn.

Now, the present application is being heard on the prayer of anticipatory bail as against petitioner no.2 only.

After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this application, in order to seek regular bail before the learned court below.

Permission is granted.

The instant application is dismissed as withdrawn.



However, the petitioner no.2 is directed to surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and seek regular bail.

The learned court below is directed to consider and dispose of the case of the petitioner no.2, preferably, on the same date in accordance with the merits of the case without being prejudiced by the withdrawal of the present application.
