4 17-10-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ order or direction for quashing the order issued vide Memo No. 1971 dated 2.11.2018 under the signature of Respondent No.1 by which taking the Salter of a letter issued on 10.7.2018 petitioner's right as



guaranteed under Article-19 (i) (g) of Constitution of India has been denied in spite continuously agitating the said issue for not debarring for a business to a citizen on the ground of residence and further be pleased to quash the order issued vide Memo No.91 dated 3.2.2018 and Memo No.296 dated 11.4.2018 and letter No.885 dated 21.5.2018 by which arbitrarily against the right guaranteed to the petitioner by the Constitution of India is claimed for allotment of the tender being a L-1 has been denied.”
