2. Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“For issuance of an appropriate writ nature of
mandamus direction commanding the
respondents to make payment of work done due
under Saarthi Raath- Phase- I of
Rs.11,86,855=00 with reference to respondents
work order letter No. SHSB/IEC-
BCC/301/2019/2102 dated 29.06.2019.

Make payment of work done due under Saarthi
Raath- Phase- II of Rs. 13,12,987.00 with



reference to respondent official work order letter no. SHSB/IEC-BCC/301/12019/5573 dated 31.10.2019.

Make payment of work done under Saghan Missin Indra Dhanush of Rs. 18,106,14=00 with reference respondent official work order letter no. SHSB/IEC-BCC/323/6371 dated 13.12.2019.

For issuance of direction to the respondent to consider the case of the petitioner to make payment of arrear due of above said claim in para -1 of the petitioner under State Health Society Bihar rules, Government of Bihar.

For issuance of an appropriate writ/order direction in favor of the petitioner as your lordship may deem fit and proper in facts and circumstances of the case.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petitioner shall be content if the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum and to take recourse to such other alternate remedies which are equally efficacious in law.
