2 08-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) (d)
of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of
recovery of six litres of liquor from a motorcycle.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, he was
not arrested from the spot as such nothing was recovered from
his conscious possession and his name transpired based on
secret information. It is next submitted that petitioner is neither



the owner nor the driver of the said motorcycle.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Majhaulia P.S. Case No. 706 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
