Accordingly, let the petitioners above named (**except Petitioner No. 3**) be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM 2, Sehohar, in connection with Tariyani P.S. Case No. 73 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
