Heard learned counsel for respective parties.

In the instant petition, petitioner has prayed for the fol-
lowing reliefs:-

*“(i) For payment of Ex-gratia,
which is being paid to the successor of
deceased police employee, who died dur-
ing the course of the duty.*

*(ii) For payment of death cum
retirement gratuity Rs. 2.50 lac in place
of Rs. 76176/-*

*(iii) For grant of all consequen-
tial benefits including penal interest.”*

On 07.03.2022, the following order was passed:-



“Heard learned counsel for respective parties.

Fifth respondent, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Muzaffarpur is hereby directed to pass a speaking order as to whether petitioner is entitled to ex-gratia amount on account of her husband death on 07.02.2020 and also that she is entitled to difference of D.C.R.G. amount as claimed in the representation dated 05.05.2019 (Anneuxre-7) or not? Such a decision shall be taken and place on record before the next date of hearing.

Relist this matter on 04.04.2022.

Copy of this order shall be given to Md. N.H. Khan, learned State Counsel.”

Today, learned counsel for the State-respondent submitted that fifth respondent has passed a speaking order on 10.05.2022. The same has been placed on record by filing counter affidavit.

In view of the aforesaid speaking order, the present petition stands disposed off reserving liberty to the petitioner to question the validity of the speaking order in accordance with law.
