name has come in the self-inculpatory confessional statement of the co-accused.

In view of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, this anticipatory bail application is not maintainable in view of the judgment of the Full Bench of this Court in the case of *Ram Binay Yadav Vs. The State of Bihar* reported in [2019 (2) PLJR 1089 (Full Bench)]. Accordingly, it is dismissed as not maintainable.
