Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Sheohar P.S. Case No. 236 of 2020 registered for the offence punishable under Section 304-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted that petitioner no.1 is *Devar* and petitioner no. 2 is *Gotni* of the deceased and they have clean antecedent.

Considering the relationship of the petitioners with the deceased, this bail application is allowed.

Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of



their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheohar, in connection with Sheohar P.S. Case No. 236 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
