2. It is submitted by the petitioner's counsel that the
Respondent No. 11 has been reinstated pursuant to order passed
in C.W.J.C. No. 20619 of 2013, as contained in Annexure-7 to
the writ petition. He raises a grievance that the order has been
passed without impleading the petitioner as a party to the above
