2 27-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Chanan P.S. Case No. 114 of 2020 registered under Sections 448/498A/341/323/308/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case due to land dispute. Petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law of the informant. There is specific allegation against the husband of the informant.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the

event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M.-I, Lakhisarai in connection with Chanan P.S. Case No. 114 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
