2 22-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 307/379 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

These petitioners are alleged to have damaged laptop and electronic gazette and took away Rs.2200/- from the cash box of the shop of the informant.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. There is no allegation of assault against these petitioners who have got no criminal antecedent.



Considering the nature of allegation against the petitioners, in the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioners, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in Birpur Police Station Case No. 155 of 2020, subject to the conditions laid down under sections 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
