for removal of encroachment from land,
appertaining to Khata No. 136, Khesra No. 90 and



91, situated at Mauza-Bahadurpur, P.S.-Sabour, District-Bhagalpur, however, the learned counsel for the Respondent-State has filed a counter affidavit wherein it has been stated that the land in question is raiyati land of the petitioner/private person, hence, the present writ petition is not maintainable.
