Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

- L To issue an appropriate order/s, direction/s including a Writ preferably in the nature of Mandamus commanding and directing upon the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner and to grant him the license for starting a Motor Vehicle Driving School as he fulfils all the criteria for the same.



- II. To direct the concerned Respondents to take necessary action against the erring authorities who did not dispose of the application of the petitioner within 90 days in accordance with Rules.
- III. To direct the Respondents to compensate the petitioner for the loss, he has incurred in meeting the eligibility criteria and maintaining the infrastructure for a period of almost three years.
- IV. To any other relief/s to which the Petitioner may found entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.

It is the petitioner's case that petitioner's application dated 28th of September, 2016 for grant of license for starting a Motor Vehicle Driving School, allegedly is yet pending consideration with the authorities.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner shall be content if a direction is issued to the authorities for expeditious disposal thereof.

Petition is disposed of with a direction to the Licensing Authority to positively consider the petitioner's application, if pending, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on merits. All issues on fact and law are left open.

The present petition stands disposed of in the



aforesaid terms.
