2 20-04-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“(i) To issue an appropriate order/s direction/s including a writ preferably in the nature of Mandamus commanding and directing upon the respondents to make the payment of admitted dues of the petitioner amounting to Rs. 2,41,801/- (Rupees Two lacs forty one thousand eight hundred and one) only in lieu of works completed by the petitioner within time against contract entered with the petitioner and respondent No. 5 vide Agreement No. 100F2/2020-21 for the work of Repair of Demarked Room, Toilet for observer and IT Cell in M.I.T. Muzaffarpur on the even of MLC Election 2020 for the year 2020-2021 and the rate approved by S.E. Building Circle Muzaffarpur vide letter No. 963 (anu) dated 09.11.2020.



(ii) To direct the respondents to make the payment of aforesaid admitted dues of the petitioner hence forthwith which has been wrongly and illegally withheld by the respondents.

(iii) To direct the respondents to make the payment of penal interest on the aforementioned dues to the petitioner on account of delay and laches on the part of the respondents.

(iv) To any other relief/s to which the petitioner is entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, as it has become infructuous.

Permission granted.

Present petition stands disposed of having become infructuous.

Interlocutory application, if any, also stands disposed of.
