2 15-12-2022 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief :-

“ (i) For issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ/writs directing the Respondent No.2 i.e. The District Magistrate, Patna for issuance/grant of an Arms Licence as per the recommendation of Police Officer or to direct the concerned authority to dispose of the application of the petitioner, which is pending since 2018.”
