Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

- i. Issue of an appropriate writ following an direction including a writ in nature of mandamus to the respondents to make an alternate arrangement for installation of the dual Transformers of Electricity Supply which has been decided to install on the door of the petitioner by the Respondent Authorities and Which is illegal too as per the provision made in Section 53 (a) of Electricity Act, 2003.



- ii. To pass an order or, direction to ensure the safety of life, not only to the petitioners' family also to general public as it is decided to install in the crowded market on the door of the petitioner;
- iii. To hold and declare that the concerned Respondents are answerable / accountable in public law for abuse and misuse of his statutory power and to fix reasonable compensation against the erring respondents payable to the petitioner;
- iv. To grant such relief / reliefs as the petitioner found entitled to and to grant cost of an incidental to the proceeding to the petitioner ;
- v. To grant any other relief / reliefs, order/ orders, direction/directions for which the petitioner is found to entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not in favour of the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach the appropriate authority venting out the surviving grievances, if any, in accordance with law.

Liberty as prayed for is granted.

The instant petition stands disposed of as withdrawn.
