The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No.344 of 2020 registered for offences under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Considering the fact that petitioner no.1 is a Government servant and petitioner no. 2 does not stay in his village, their application for anticipatory bail is allowed.



Accordingly, let petitioners, above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise Court-1, Gopalganj in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No.344 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
