Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Mansoorchak P.S. Case No. 32 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable under Section 304-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The petitioner no.1 is the mother-in-law of the deceased and there is specific allegation against her of torture for demand of dowry. Hence, this bail application on behalf of petitioner no.1, above named, is dismissed.

The petitioner no. 2 is the brother-in-law (*Devar*) of the deceased.



Considering the fact that the petitioner no.2 is the junior member of the family, this bail application is allowed on behalf of petitioner no. 2.

Let the petitioner no.2, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Begusarai, in connection with Mansoorchak P.S. Case No. 32 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
