The petitioner has prayed for the following relief/s :-

“For issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing and commanding the respondents to make payment of the amount with regard to the carriage of stone chips and sand in work in question and to refund the security deposit money to the petitioner in view of order dated 16.05.2017 passed by the respondent No.4 and be further pleased to direct the respondent No.4 to pay



the statutory interest upon the aforesaid amount which was not paid in reasonable time.”

In view of the fact that Bihar Public Works Dispute Arbitration Tribunal is now functional, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to such other appropriate remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

As and when any such request is made by the petitioner before the Tribunal, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
