**ORAL ORDER**

2      12-09-2022              The petitioner has filed the present writ petition for grant of permission to the petitioner to start Skill Development Centre, after completing the formalities on the premises / location on which the respondents have already given permission.

The Respondents have filed a counter affidavit wherein it has been stated that for the purposes of setting up a Kushal Yuva Centre, the Bihar Skill Development Mission has prescribed the



essential criterias, as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 2 of the counter affidavit, filed by the respondents. It has also been submitted in the said counter affidavit, filed by the Respondents that the petitioner along with 36 other applicants had produced proof, by submitting original invoices regarding purchase of computers etc., after completion of the registration process, nonetheless, the Bihar Skill Development Mission had taken a decision that no new centre could be opened within a radius of 2 K.M. of any existing centre, if the new centre is situated in rural area and within a radius of 1 K.M., if the existing center is situated in an urban area. It is also stated in the counter affidavit that barring the petitioner, all other 35 organizations, who had registered, have completed their registration process and the Kushal Yuva Training Programme is also being run by them, however, as far as the petitioner is concerned, the Bihar Skill Development Mission has got no reservation in giving approval to the center of the petitioner, if he complies with the



eligibility criteria and other rules laid down by the Bihar Skill Development Mission.

In such view of the matter, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing survives for consideration in the present writ petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of as having become infructuous.
