Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Risiup P.S. Case No. 93 of 2021 for the offence punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

The petitioner is the registered owner of the Apache motorcycle, from which illicit liquor has been recovered, which was being used by her husband, who has been arrested by the police. The petitioner is a young lady.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of her arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, IX- cum-Special Judge, Excise, II, Aurangabad, in connection with Risiup P.S. Case No. 93 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
