2 09-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners pray for bail in a case registered for the offence under Section 272, 273 of the I.P.C. and Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

84 liters of country-made liquor has been recovered from the Toddy shop of the petitioners.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners and they have been made accused only on suspicion. Petitioners claim clean antecedent and are in custody since 21.12.2021. Investigation is complete.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.



Considering the nature of allegation, clean antecedent and period of custody, the bail petition of petitioners is allowed. Let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court No. 1 cum Additional District and Sessions Judge, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No. 247 of 2021.
