Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Mahindwara P.S. Case No. 52 of 2021 for the offence punishable under Sections 30/30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

The petitioner has not been arrested on the spot. His name has been taken by co-accused.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been implicated because of previous enmity and earlier also he was falsely implicated in a case registered under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, in which he is on bail.



Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Exclusive Special Excise Court-1, Sitamarhi, in connection with Mahindwara P.S. Case No. 52 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
