ORAL ORDER

2 29-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioners pray for bail in a case registered for the offence under Section 30(a)(d), 37(c) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Total 20 liters of country-made *Mahua* liquor has been recovered from respective house of the petitioners.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. Recovery has been made from the houses, which are in joint possession of the family. Petitioners claim clean antecedent and are in custody since 18.01.2022.



Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

Considering the nature of allegation, clean antecedent and period of custody, the bail petition of petitioners is allowed. Let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court – 2, Nawada in connection with Rajauli P.S. Case No. 14 of 2022.
