The matter is heard via video conferencing due to circumstances prevailing on account of the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. State counsel accepts notice for respondents.

3. In the instant petition, petitioner has prayed for the following relief/reliefs:

“(i) Commanding the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as sweeper in P & T Dispensary, Chapra.

(ii) Commanding the respondents to pay all consequential monetary benefits / salary etc. as applicable to the sweeper of such dispensary (which is a sanctioned post) and



(iii) Grant such other relief deemed fit and proper.”

4. Petitioner’s grievance is against one of the post in the Postal Department, Government of India. If a person has any grievance in respect of post in a Department of Government of India, such person has to invoke Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 and in terms of ***L. Chandra Kumar vs. Union of India and Others*** reported in **(1997) 3 SCC 261** read with the case of ***S.P. Sampath Kumar vs. Union of India*** reported in **(1987) 1 SCC 124**.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is not maintainable under Article 226 of the Constitution, hence, writ petition stands disposed off reserving liberty to the petitioner to invoke remedy before appropriate forum.
