2 14-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 30(a), 37(b)(c) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

700 ml. of foreign liquor has been recovered from the possession of two co-accused persons, who disclosed the name of petitioner, as their associate, who fled away after seeing the police.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Recovery has been made from an open place behind Ara Machine and petitioner has been made accused only on the basis of disclosure made by co-accused. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.



Considering the nature of allegation and clean antecedent of petitioner, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt / production of copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna in connection with Budha Colony P.S. Case No. 474 of 2021 (Special Case No. 8716 of 2021), subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
