2 31-03-2022 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present anticipatory bail application as against **Petitioner No. 3 and Petitioner No. 4.**

Permitted to be withdrawn.

It is, thus, dismissed as withdrawn as against **Petitioner No. 3 and Petitioner No. 4.**

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.



The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Sathi P.S. Case No. 242/2021 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Five litres of illicit liquor has been recovered from the bush. Petitioner No. 1 and Petitioner No. 2 have been named along with others. They have clean antecedents.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.

Accordingly, let the **Petitioner No. 1 and Petitioner No. 2.** above named be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, West Champaran, Bettiah, in connection with Sathi P.S. Case No. 242/2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
